Balham Styling Features



- 1. Horizontal lines create uninterrupted lines across the kitchen with repeated use of wide drawers or uninterrupted high lines.
- 2. Vertical lines Blocks of tower units create clean and uncluttered vertical lines, give height to a room and easier access to appliances.
- 3. Corners return lines around corners with external / internal corner posts and returned plinths
- 4. Wall units minimise the use of wall units, using half heights with a mix of glazed and solid frontals. Adding bespoke shelving adds personality through individual styling. To maximise the minimalist contemporary look neither a cornice or pelmet is required, this keeps the lines crisp.
- 5. Thin worktops situated flush with the frontals give a clean linear look and creates the floating effect
- 6. Design with minimalist appliances ceramic hobs, integrated appliances and under mount sinks compliment the clean lines of the kitchen.
- 7. Lighting should be used to enhance the design features and add to the ultra modern feel. Flexi strip lighting fitted under worktops and around plinths highlight the floating effect, whilst fitted behind half height wall units creates mood lighting and shows of the linear look.
- 8. Open plan the Balham kitchen can flow effortlessly into living spaces by creating functional solutions for open plan living.
